On **September 14** during both services we will be hearing about the Christians currently living in the Holy Land. More than 70% of the Christian community in the Holy Land depends on tourism as their only source of income, but tourism there has plummeted for a number of reasons. The pandemic, a 12-yard wall around Bethlehem, and the catastrophic ongoing war have all made their impact on these families. Between and after services, these Christians will be bringing their beautiful handmade olivewood crafts to sell to benefit their families.
