
Sunday, December 7 at 5pm




Do Not Be Afraid

2025 YEAR-END GIFTS and Estimate of Giving Cards

As you plan your year-end giving, please note that the last day the office will be open in 2025 is Wednesday, December 31st until noon. Any contributions received by noon will be counted towards 2025 giving.

YEAR-END STOCK & IRA CONTRIBUTIONS

As Christians, we believe in being good stewards of what God has entrusted to us. To that end, consider the advantages of giving stock to Hope Lutheran Church. By donating appreciated stock to a charitable organization, you avoid paying capital gains tax on the increased value of the stock. You may also be able to take a deduction for the market value of the stock at the time it was given. If you plan to give securities to the Church, please notify Cindy Franklin at (419) 536-8383 to help facilitate the process.

Another option is making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) from your IRA. The gift stays out of your adjusted gross income only if you make a direct transfer from your IRA to the charity. It doesn't count as a tax-free transfer if you withdraw the money first and then make a donation to the charity. Please consult your tax advisor on either matter.

Thank you to everyone that has returned their **2026 Estimate of Giving card**. If you have not done so yet, please consider turning it in to state your intentions for next year. It is helpful for the Hope Finance Team to have an indication of your financial intentions as we prepare the 2026 budget. We realize that you are only offering an estimate and that circumstances can change throughout the year.
